

The Capri Campus for Forensic & Security Studies, in collaboration with the City University of New York (with approval from the New York City College of Technology Provost dated 18/02/2024) and the Municipality of Cassano all'Jonio (Municipal Council Resolution No. 74 of 02/04/2024), has established the "Inter-University Laboratory of Sybaris" for high-level training and studies "Blue, Green & Orange Economy, Archaeology from Space Initiative."

On April 2, 2024, the Municipal Council convened under Mayor Giovanni Papasso, acknowledging the Privacy and Security Commission (a body of the Naples Council of the Lawyers) that manages the high-level training initiative called Capri Campus "Forensic & Security." Coordinated by Attorney Sergio Falcone, with a record on file number 6241 dated 29.02.2024, it was suggested to organize a workshop in Cassano all'Jonio to host study programs from the City University of New York and other Capri Campus partner universities, thus forming the "Inter-University Laboratory of Sybaris." The Municipality of Cassano all'Jonio aims to foster cooperation between educational institutions, public entities, and economic operators on a regional, national, and international scale. The Capri Campus, in partnership with various professional orders, national associations like CSIT (Innovative and Technological Services), ASAS, INFORAV, and foreign partners, hosts study programs abroad from American universities, specifically the University of California in San José (SJSU) and the City University of New York, as well as projects from Italian universities such as the University of Bergamo and Federico II. For the summer session of 2024, Capri Campus plans to conclude the semester in Sybaris for the City Tech School of Architecture in New York and has organized a project focused on the Cassano area named "Blue, Green & Orange Economy, Archaeology from Space Initiative." The program engages American professors and students in study and research initiatives in the area, with a focus on environmental, maritime economy, and cultural heritage, especially rediscovering the ancient roots of Western culture through remote sensing and space technologies. The proposed initiative is of significant cultural and scientific importance. The Council has decided to endorse the proposal by the Privacy and Security Commission - Capri Campus "Forensic & Security" for the "Inter-University Laboratory of Sybaris" and to grant patronage for the realization of events, seminars, workshops, and labs, in agreement with the Municipal Administration. It delegates the Head of Area II, Socio-Cultural Tourism Sector, the enactment of subsequent acts to the realization of the "Inter-University Laboratory of Sybaris." Thus, the Council, in accordance with Legislative Decree No. 267/2000 (T.U.E.L.), unanimously voted to consider the premises expressed in the narrative as an integral and substantial part of this act; to grant, as a directive, to the Capri Campus "Forensic & Security," the patronage for the realization of events, seminars, workshops, and labs, in agreement with the Municipal Administration, and to transmit the Council Resolution to Area II, Socio-Cultural Tourism Sector; and to make the Council Resolution immediately executable under Article 134, paragraph 4, of Legislative Decree No. 267/2000 (T.U.E.L.).

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL HAVING NOTED

- that the Privacy and Security Commission (an institution of the Naples Council of Lawyers), directs a high-level training and studies initiative named Capri Campus "Forensic & Security" and through its Coordinator, Lawyer Sergio Falcone, with a note in the records under prot. n.6241 of 29.02.2024, has highlighted the opportunity to organize in Cassano All'Ionio, a laboratory capable of hosting study programs of the City University of New York and other university partners of the Capri-Campus, establishing the "Inter-University Lab of Sibari";
- that the Municipality of Cassano All'Ionio intends to encourage forms of cooperation between educational institutions, public entities, and economic operators on a regional, national, and international scale;

GIVEN THAT

the Capri Campus, in partnership with the Order of Accountants, the Order of Journalists, national Confindustria (CSIT Innovative and Technological Services), the industrial associations ASAS, INFORAV, and foreign partners, hosts the study abroad program of some American universities, in particular, the University of California in San Jose (SJSU) and the City University New York, in addition to projects of Italian universities such as the University of Bergamo and Federico II.;

CONSIDERING THAT:

→ for the summer session of 2024, the Capri Campus intends to conclude at Sibari the semester for the school of architecture technology of City Tech of New York and has organized a project focused on the territory of Cassano named "Blue, Green & Orange Economy, Archaeology from Space Initiative";

→ the program involves American teachers and students in study and research initiatives on the territory, in a context of studies on environmental, maritime economy, and cultural heritage, and particularly on the rediscovery of the ancient roots of Western culture also through remote sensing and space technologies;

ACKNOWLEDGING THAT

the proposed initiative is of significant cultural merit and scientific importance;

CONSIDERING THAT

it is the intention of this Administration to give concrete implementation to the "Principle of Horizontal Subsidiarity", promoting those on the territory who realize initiatives, in the interest of the community and without profit, aimed at fostering the well-being of the community;

GIVEN THAT the Municipal Administration is inclined to promote and support all those high cultural caliber initiatives that allow our territory to be valorized;

DEEMED

for the reasons expressed above, to accept the proposal made by the Privacy and Security Commission – Capri Campus "Forensic & Security" named "Inter-University Lab of Sibari";

ALSO DEEMED

to grant, as an Act of Direction, to the Capri Campus "Forensic & Security", the Patronage for the realization of events, seminars, laboratories, and workshops, to be agreed jointly with the Municipal Administration, delegating to the Head of Area II, Socio-Touristic Cultural Sector the adoption of consequential acts for the realization of the "Inter-University Lab of Sibari";

L'anno 2024 il giorno 02 del mese di Aprile si è riunita la Giunta Comunale, il Sindaco Giovanni Papasso, ha invitato la Giunta a prendere atto che la Commissione Privacy e Security (istituto del Consiglio dell'Ordine degli Avvocati di Napoli), dirige un'iniziativa di alta formazione e studi denominata Capri Campus “Forensic & Security” e per il tramite del suo Coordinatore, l'Avv.
